We ask that you please respect the age guidelines for both the teen track (**13 & up**) and the children's art class (**6-12**). Thank you.

Children: While most sessions are designed for adults, the art class is for **registered** children (**ages 6-12**), admitted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Children may attend one session or the other, not both. While we encourage you to bring your children, they must be **supervised at all times**, and they will be charged the child registration fee (exception – children under 5). *A small lift between floors is available for mothers with strollers and those unable to use stairs.*

Food: We regret that we cannot provide meals for visitors, due to the unpredictability of the attendee count. Also, food and beverages, other than bottled water, are restricted to certain areas. However, the convention location offers a wide variety of restaurants—many within walking distance. You may also pack a lunch for an outdoor picnic, weather permitting.

Volunteers: We have a great need for servants (adults and teens) who would like to help the convention to run smoothly. Check-in: Check-in at the registration desk, especially on Friday, can be time-consuming. Please allow at least a half-hour for this, or you may risk missing a portion or the entirety of the first workshop you plan to attend.
